Coin clubs at all levels – local or regional must maintain an online presence to survive in today's internet-focused world.

Whether it's with a website or through social media (such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and YouTube), this online presence is paramount in promoting a club's visibility. Using the Internet, it's now easier than ever for numismatists to reach like-minded people researcher, historians and bankers to name just a few - but it's all for nothing if their online presence is out of date or not engaging.

The bottom line is that what you get out of your website or Facebook page is directly proportional to what you put into it. Beyond club promotion, an up-to-date website with relevant and engaging content is one of the best ways to promote the hobby in general.
